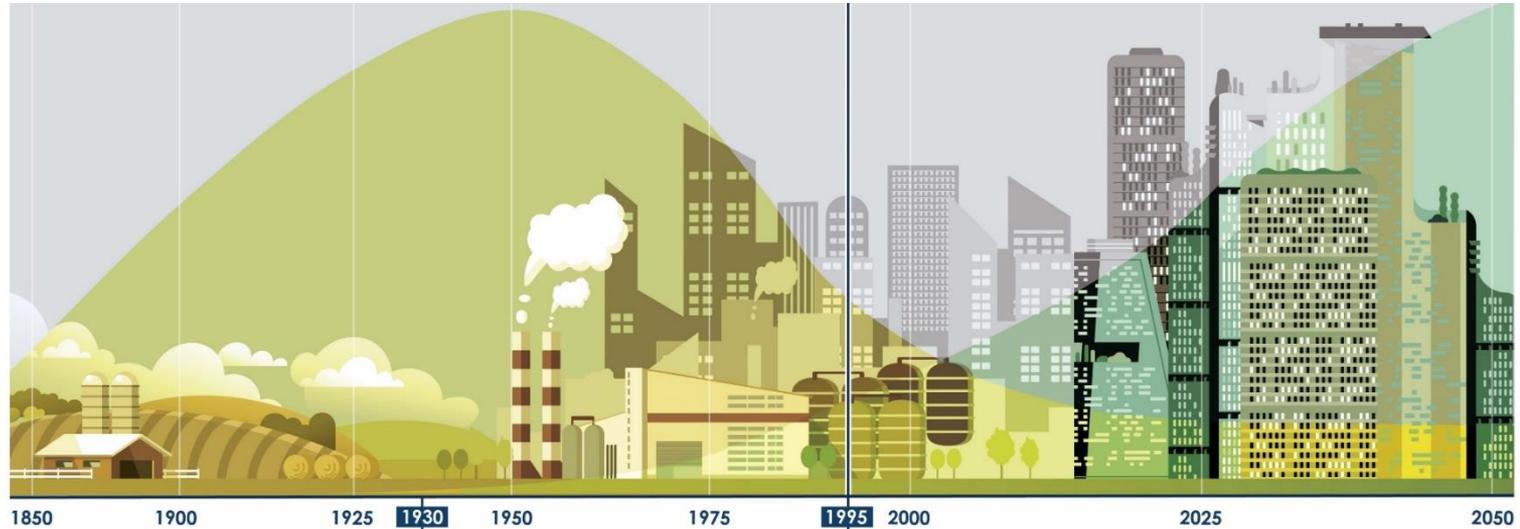

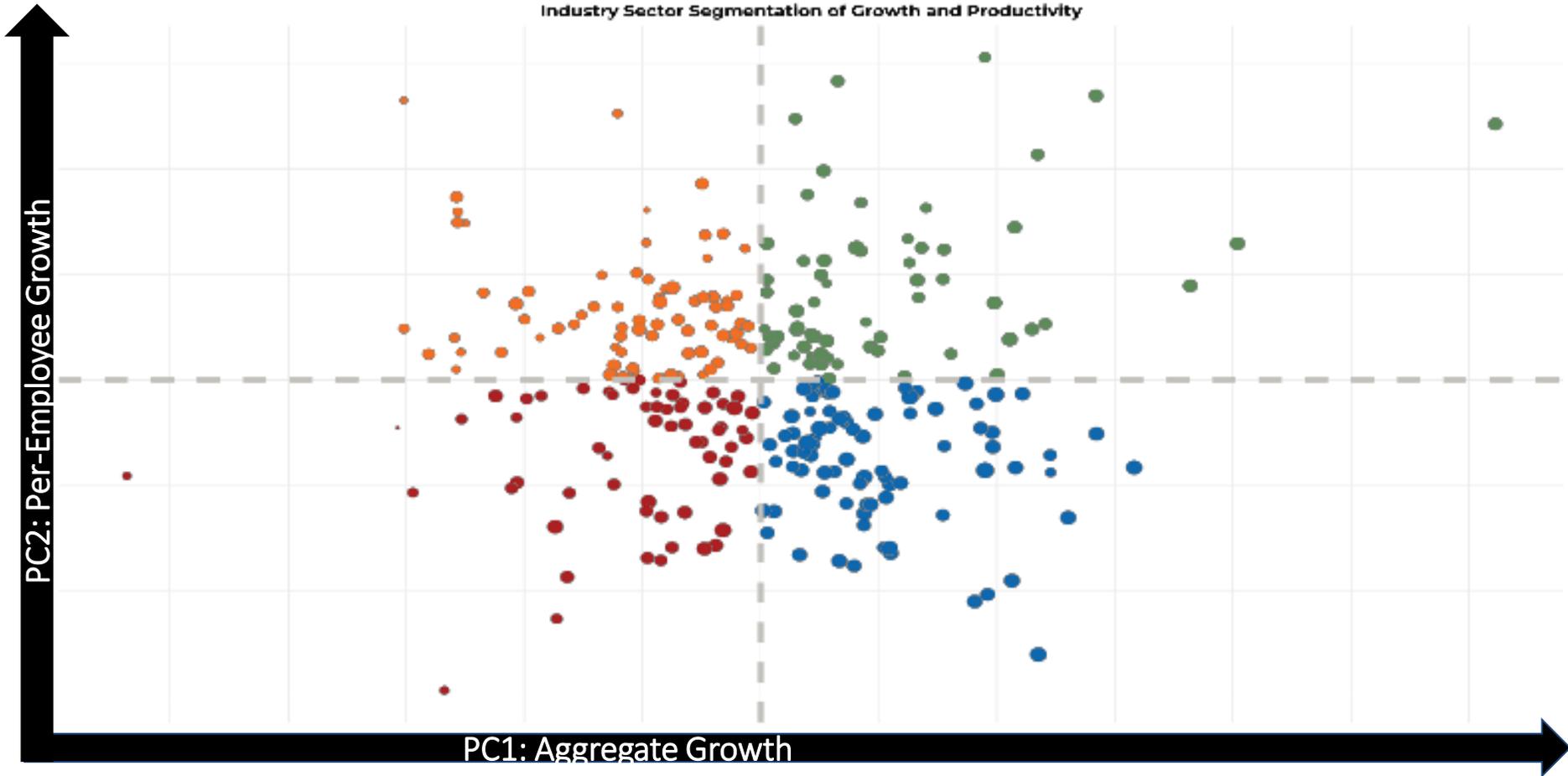

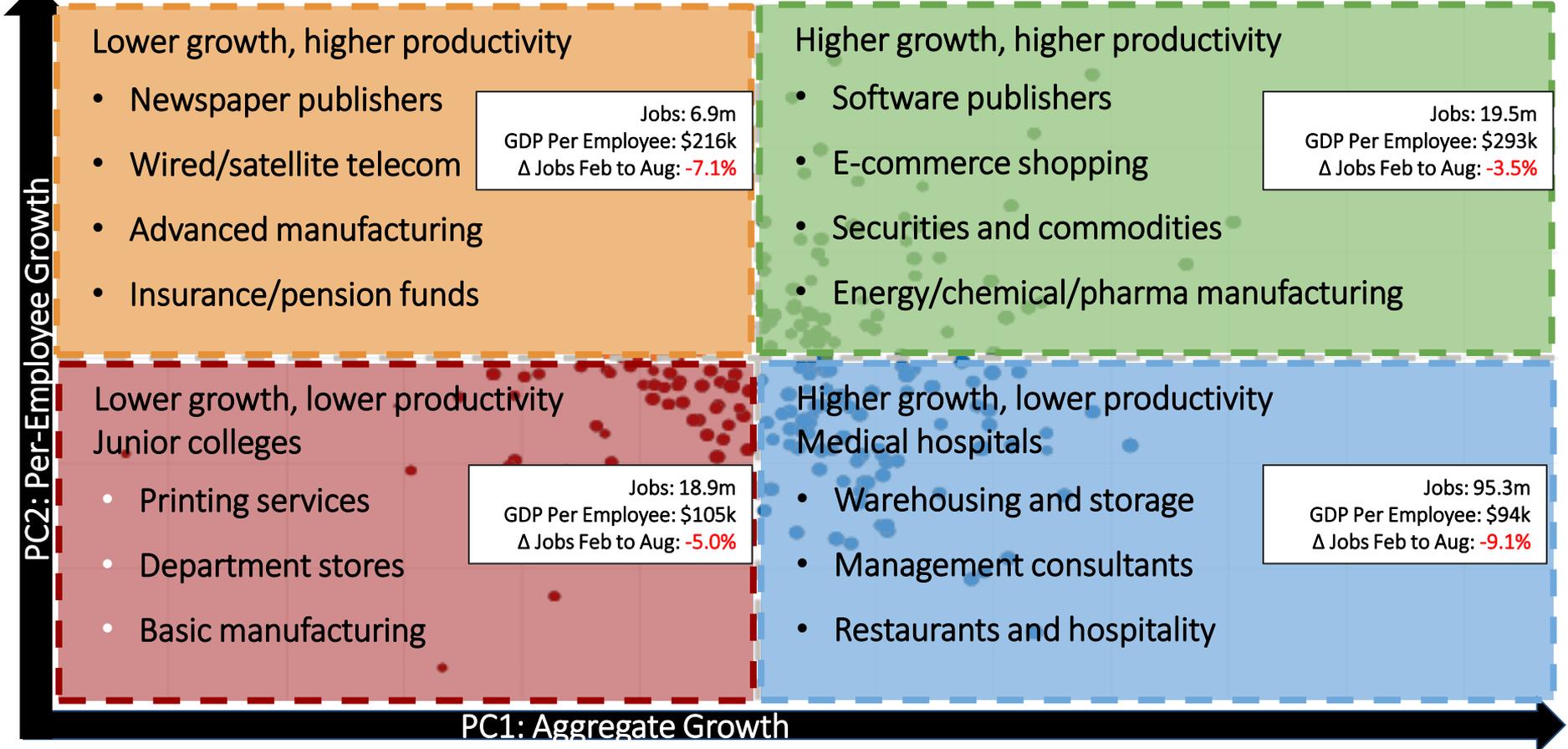
# Dissecting US Labor Market

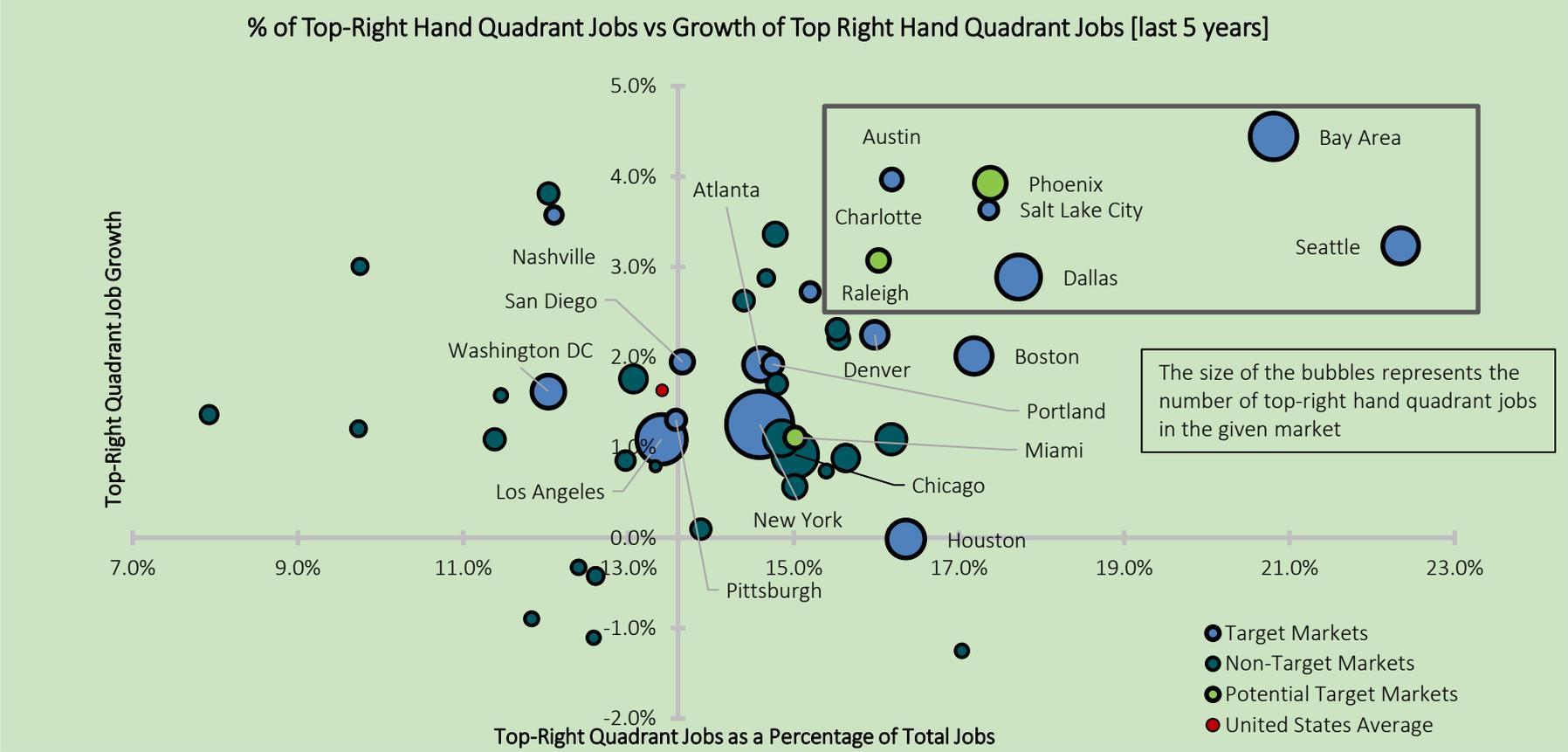
# Identifying the High Productivity Jobs

Industry Sector Segmentation of Growth and Productivity



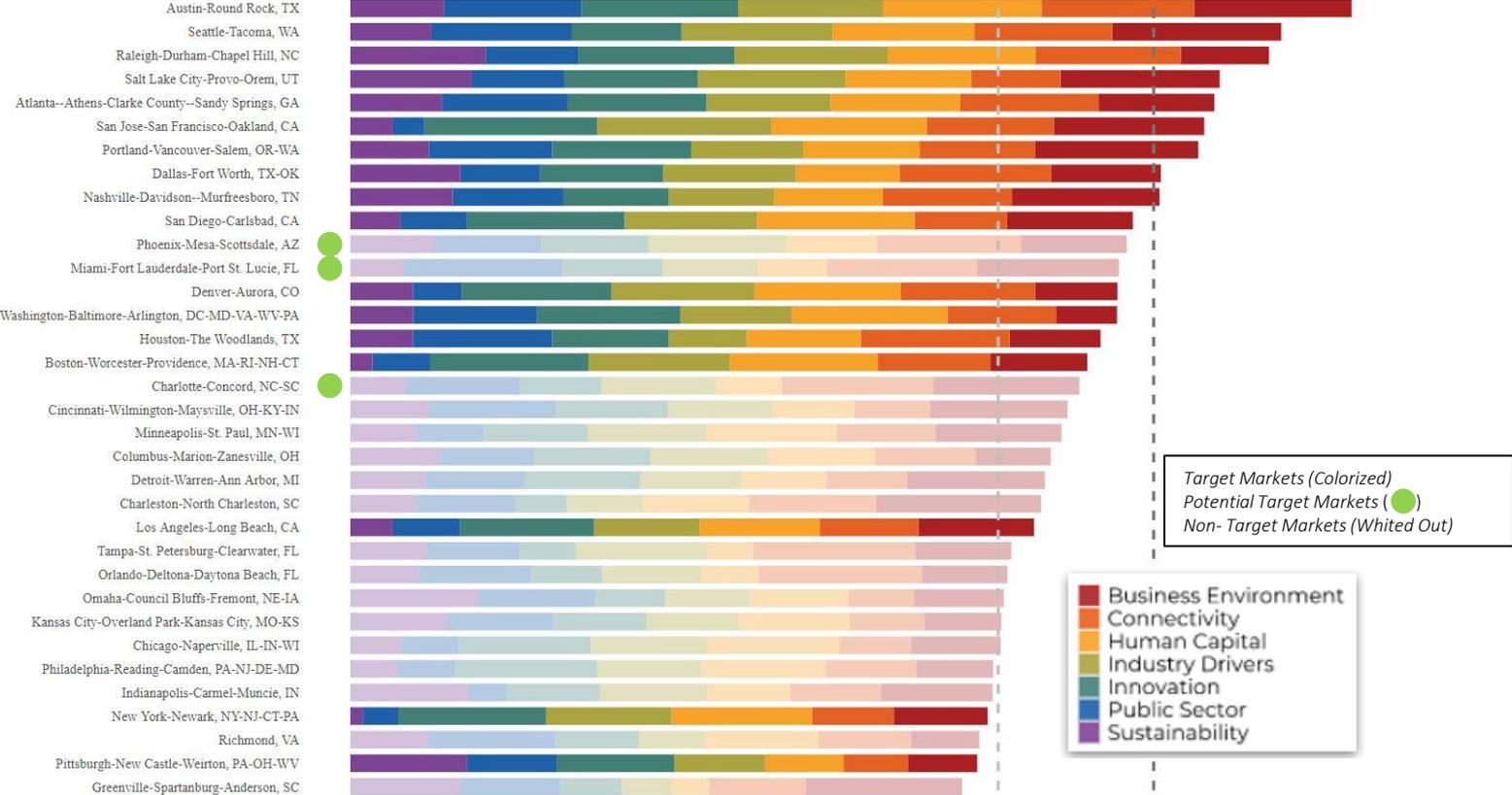

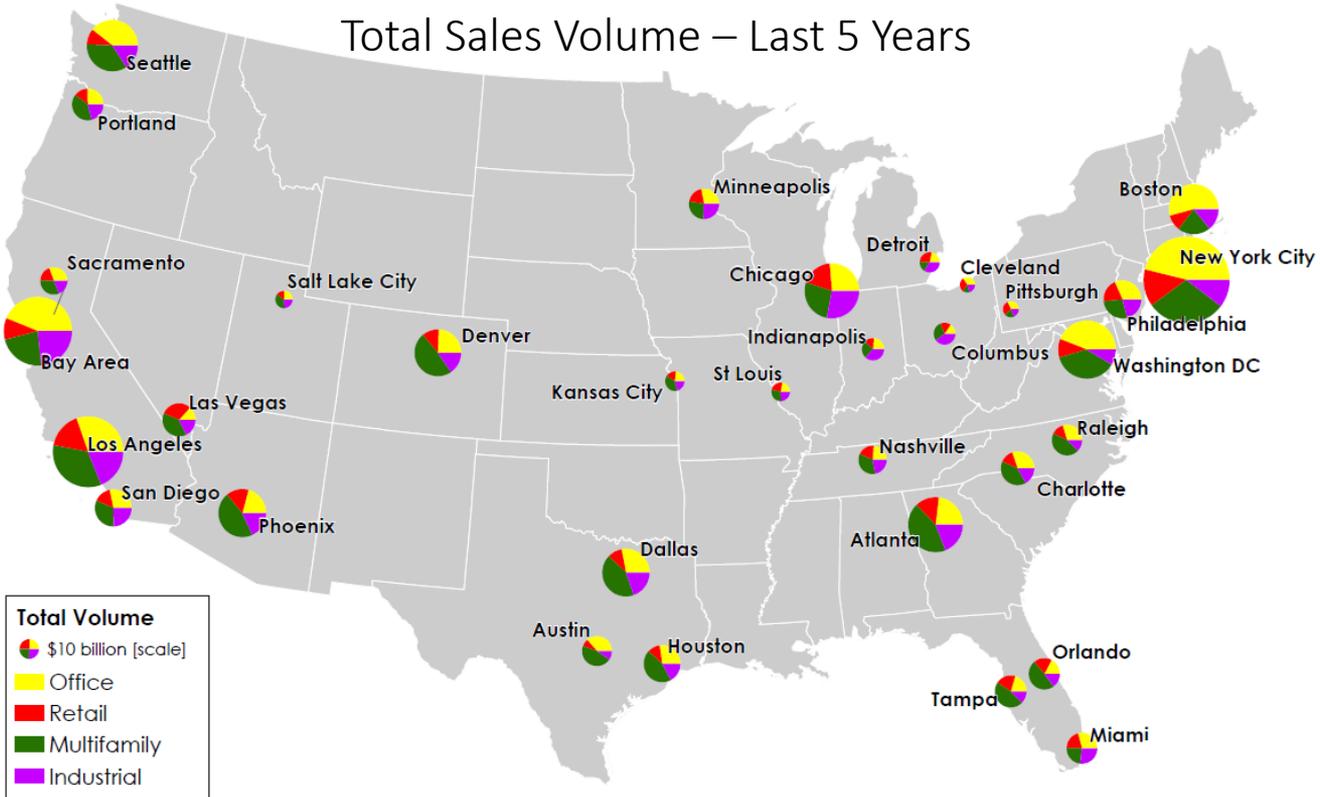
